

Help With Heating Bills (LIHEAP)

What is LIHEAP?

- LIHEAP provides grants to help with a heating bill.
- This includes bills for electricity, gas, water, oil, kerosene, or other fuel types.
- LIHEAP is typically only available November through March.

What type of help can I get from LIHEAP?

- <u>Cash Grant</u> Pays at least **<u>\$100</u>** to help with a heating bill.
- <u>Crisis grant</u> Pays up to **<u>\$500</u>** to prevent a utility shut off or to restore service.
- Interface program Repair or replacement of broken heaters.

How do I apply for LIHEAP?

Visit your local County Assistance Office or apply online at: <u>www.compass.state.pa.us</u>.

Who can get LIHEAP?

Households must have income lower than either the monthly **OR** annual limits listed below and must be responsible for paying for heat.

What are the income limits for the 2015-2016 LIHEAP Season?

Household Size	Monthly Income	Yearly Income
1	\$1471	\$17,655
2	\$1991	\$23,895
3	\$2511	\$30,135
4	\$3031	\$36,375

What happens if I am denied?

You can appeal within 30 days. An appeal form will be included with your denial notice.
