

# Calculating Future Sealing Eligibility

## If the record has...

### 4 cases with M2 convictions or higher

## The future eligibility date is the *latest* date of the following:

Identify the 4 most recent cases with M2 convictions or higher. Add 15 years to disposition date of the *oldest* of the 4 cases.

### Felony conviction for:

- Pt. II Art. B offense – danger to person;
- Pt. II Art. D offense – offense against family;
- Ch. 61 offense – firearms/other dangerous articles; or
- §9799.14/.55– sexual offense/tier system/registration

Add 15 years to the most recent conviction disposition date for any of the listed offenses.

### Or any conviction for:

- Indecent exposure;
- Sexual intercourse w/ animal;
- Failure to comply w/registration requirements;
- Weapons/implements for escape;
- Abuse of corpse; or
- Prohibited paramilitary training

### 2 cases with M1 or felony convictions

Identify the 2 most recent cases with M1 or felony convictions. Add 10 years to the disposition date of the *older* of the 2 cases.

### An M or F conviction in the last 10 years and you are sealing a *felony*

Add 10 years to the most recent misdemeanor or felony conviction.

### An M or F conviction in the last 7 years and you are sealing a *misdemeanor*

Add 7 years to the most recent misdemeanor or felony conviction.
